## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

The Member, each Adult Participant, and Member on behalf of minor Participants (those under age 18) and on behalf of any other parent or legal guardian of any minor Participants, in consideration of Member's membership in Ski Bees and the Member's and Participants' right to participate in Ski Bees activities, hereby acknowledge, agree, promise and covenant with Ski Bees, for ourselves and our heirs, assigns, personal representatives, and estates, as follows:

**Acknowledgement of Risks:** Participants (which term for the remainder of this document, includes the Member and any adult or minor Participant) understands and acknowledges that the activities of the Ski Bees in which a Participant engages in bear certain anticipated and unanticipated risks which could result in injury, death, illness, or disease, physical or mental damage to the Participant, other persons, or property.

**Acceptance of Risk and Responsibility:** Participant voluntarily agrees, covenants, and promises to accept and assume all responsibilities for injury, death, illness, or disease to the Participant, or other persons or property arise from the Participant's participation in Ski Bees activities. Participant's participation in Ski Bees activities is purely voluntary; no one is forcing the Participant to participate despite the risks.

**Acknowledgement of Effect of this Release Agreement:** Participant understands and acknowledges that the Participant has given up certain rights and/or possible claims which the Participant might otherwise assert or maintain against the Released Parties, including specifically but not limited to, rights arising from claims for the acts or omissions, fault, negligence in any degree of any of the Released Parties. Participant has assumed responsibility and legal liability for the claims or other legal demands, including defense costs, which may be asserted against the Participant, or the Released Parties, because of the Participant's participation in Ski Bees activities.

**Medical Care, Participant Insurance Benefits, Representation of Physical Conditions, and Drug Testing:** Ski Bees will not provide any medical insurance coverage to the Participant. Participant certifies the Participant has sufficient health, accident, and personal liability coverage to cover any bodily injury or property damage that the Participant may incur while participating in Ski Bees activities, and to cover bodily injury or property damage caused to another party because of the Participant's participation in Ski Bees activities. Participant further acknowledges that the Participant is in good physical and mental health, and not suffering from any condition, disease, or disablement, which would or could potentially affect participation in Ski Bees activities. Participant gives consent and permission to Ski Bees and any health or emergency care provider to obtain or administer on behalf of the Participant, first aid and emergency medical treatment in case of sickness, accident, or injury and to secure medical care at the Participant's expense and to make decisions concerning medical care. Participant gives consent to the drug testing of the Participant upon Ski Bees request if the Participant is involved in any incident involving injury to the Participant, other persons, or damage to property. Participant gives consent for drug testing to be performed during the course of any medical care or treatment for the Participant.

**Entire Agreement:** Participant understands that this is the Entire Agreement between Ski Bees and the Participant, that it is for the benefit of all Released Parties, and that it can only be modified in writing signed by the Ski Bees. The undersigned are at least 18 years of age, of sound mind, and not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at this time. The undersigned have read this entire document, including the **RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION** attached (Page 14) to this Application, understands it completely, and agrees to be bound by its terms.

By signing, the Member represents that the Member is the parent or legal guardian of all Participants under the age of 18 and that the member has express authority for any non-signing parent or legal guardian to execute this release on behalf of any minor Participant(s) and such non-signing parent or legal guardian. You will not be a Member of Ski Bees until such a time that this application is accepted by an authorized representative of Ski Bees and your initial dues are paid in full.

**USA WATER SKI SAFE SPORT CERTIFICATION:** ALL Adult Active members (age 18 and over) who are in contact with children under the age of 18 as a part of the Ski Bees are required to take the "Safe Sport" Course offered online by USA Water Ski, which can be found at: <https://www.teamusa.org/usa-water-ski/safe-sport>. This is a REQUIREMENT by USA Water Ski to create a safer environment for all our participants.

## PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT LAKE MCQUEENEY SKI BEES, INC.

Membership in the Lake McQueeney Ski Bees, Inc. ("Ski Bees") is open to all individuals interested in the sport of Water Skiing. We have a long history of performing on Lake McQueeney and have been operating as a club since 1952! To participate in club practices, shows, or events, all Members and Participants are required to sign the following agreement. This agreement cannot establish a complete set of rules which prescribe every aspect of appropriate and safe behavior but covers the basic guidelines of participation. By signing this agreement, the Member and Participants agree to abide by its provisions as well as others that might arise.

- I will treat other skiers, show leaders, and Board Members with respect at all times.
- I will respect the property of others, whether personal or public.
- I will arrive for practices and shows on time, with equipment ready.
- I understand that I must attend the practice prior to a show in which I wish to participate or discuss the circumstances and get approval from the Show Director in advance.
- I must attend and participate in the Safety Meeting prior to every practice or show.
- I understand that all skiers 15 years of age and under must have a parent or legal guardian on premises during events.
- I understand that there may be requirements for participation in certain acts, such as dock starts, etc.
- I understand that the Show Director has the final discretion on whether a skier is in an act or the show.
- I understand that the only people allowed on the Start Dock are the Show Director, authorized Dock Crew, and the skiers preparing for the next act.
- I agree to abide by all safety requirements set forth by the Show Director and Safety Officer and/or Board Members including using all required safety equipment and acting responsibly while participating in the show (no horseplay).
- I understand that I must return and properly store equipment to the storage shed after each practice and each show. In the event that I do not help, I understand that I may not be allowed to participate in future events.
- If I find that any equipment that I have used is damaged or inoperable, I will notify the Show Director, Safety Officer, or Board Member so that the item can be repaired or replaced.
- I will not drink alcohol or use any illegal substance before or during a Ski Bee activity. Violations will result in immediate dismissal from the Ski Bees.
- I will refrain from any vulgar, lewd, or obscene language or gestures while participating in Ski Bees activities.

Failure to abide by this agreement may result in disciplinary action, including suspension and/or expulsion from the Ski Bees.

## ADDITIONAL WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

1. I acknowledge and accept that I am personally responsible for my safety and actions while participating in practices, shows, competitions, and all other events with the **Lake McQueeney Ski Bees, Inc. ("Ski Bees")**. I agree to comply with all Ski Bees policies and rules, including but not limited to all Ski Bees policies, guidelines, signage, and instructions.
2. I acknowledge that conditions on Lake McQueeney have been significantly changed by the reduction in the level of the Lake as a part of the reconstruction of the Lake McQueeney dam and that such conditions are expected to last for several years until the completion of the dam and refilling of Lake McQueeney.
3. The Ski Bees' first concern remains safety. The Ski Bees will do what is possible to ensure that the current Lake conditions are safe for waterskiing practices and performances.
4. I understand, acknowledge and assume the risks and dangers associated with participation in the Activities, including without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury, sickness and disease, permanent disability, paralysis and loss of life; loss of or damage to equipment/property; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; contact with other participants, spectators, boats, animals or other natural or manmade objects; dangers arising from adverse weather conditions; imperfect ski course conditions; water and surface hazards; equipment failure; inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations unknown to or beyond the immediate control of the Club; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("**Risks**"). I understand that these Risks may be caused in whole or in part by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activities, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby expressly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses which I incur as a result of my participation in any Activities.
5. The Ski Bees do not believe that the current conditions on Lake McQueeney would be significantly unsafe as compared to the previous conditions of the Lake or compared to other venues such as private or competition bodies of water, either natural or man-made. However, we cannot guarantee that injury would not occur.
6. I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all costs, expenses, damages, claims, lawsuits, judgments, losses, and/or liabilities (including attorney fees) arising either directly or indirectly from or related to any and all claims made by or against any of the Released Parties due to bodily injury, death, loss of use, monetary loss, or any other injury from or related to my use Ski Bees facilities, tools, equipment, or materials, whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties or otherwise specifically related current conditions on Lake McQueeney.
7. By signing below I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing Waiver of Liability, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed, including without limitation the Release of Liability and Indemnification requirements contained in this document; I have had the opportunity to discuss this with an attorney; I am sufficiently informed about the risks involved to decide whether to sign this document; no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written agreement, have been made and this document subsumes all prior representations, warranties and agreements, both oral and written.
8. I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent; and I execute this document for full, adequate, and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by the same.
  - a. For minors under eighteen (18) years of age, a parent or legal guardian must execute this document on behalf of such minor child or children.
9. I agree that this Wavier of Liability shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Texas law, and that if any of the provisions hereof are found to be unenforceable, the remainder shall be enforced as fully as possible, and the unenforceable provision(s) shall be deemed modified to the limited extent required to permit enforcement of the Wavier of Liability as a whole.

With full awareness and appreciation of the risks involved, I, for myself and on behalf of my family, spouse, estate, heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and personal representatives, hereby forever release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Lake McQueeney Ski Bees, Inc., the Lake Breeze Ski Lodge, or its board members, officers, agents, servants, affiliates, employees, successors, and assigns (collectively the "Released Parties") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me related to COVID-19 and/or other communicable diseases whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties, any third-party, while participating in any Ski Bees activity.
3. I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all costs, expenses, damages, claims, lawsuits, judgments, losses, and/or liabilities (including attorney fees) arising either directly or indirectly from or related to any and all claims made by or against any of the Released Parties due to bodily injury, death, loss of use, monetary loss, or any other injury from or related to my use Ski Bees facilities, tools, equipment, or materials, whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties or otherwise specifically related to COVID-19 and/or other communicable diseases.

By signing below I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing Waiver of Liability, understand it and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed, including without limitation the Release of Liability and Indemnification requirements contained in this document; I have had the opportunity to discuss this with an attorney; I am sufficiently informed about the risks involved to decide whether to sign this document; no oral representations, statements, or inducements, apart from the foregoing written agreement, have been made and this document subsumes all prior representations, warranties and agreements, both oral and written.

# HEADS UP Concussion Waiver

This sheet has information to help protect your children or teens from concussion or other serious brain injury. Use this information at your children's or teens' games and practices to learn how to spot a concussion and what to do if a concussion occurs.

## **What Is a Concussion?**

A concussion is a type of traumatic brain injury—or TBI—caused by a bump, blow, or jolt to the head or by a hit to the body that causes the head and brain to move quickly back and forth. This fast movement can cause the brain to bounce around or twist in the skull, creating chemical changes in the brain and sometimes stretching and damaging the brain cells.

## **How Can I Help Keep My Children or Teens Safe?**

Sports are a great way for children and teens to stay healthy and can help them do well in school. To help lower your children or teens' chances of getting a concussion or other serious brain injury, you should:

- Help create a culture of safety for the team.
  - Work with their coach to teach ways to lower the chances of getting a concussion.
  - Talk with your children or teens about concussion and ask if they have concerns about reporting a concussion. Talk with them about their concerns; emphasize the importance of reporting concussions and taking time to recover from one.
  - Ensure that they follow their coach's rules for safety and the rules of the sport.
  - Tell your children or teens that you expect them to practice good sportsmanship at all times.
- When appropriate for the sport or activity, teach your children or teens that they must wear a helmet to lower the chances of the most serious types of brain or head injury. However, there is no “concussion-proof” helmet. So, even with a helmet, it is important for children and teens to avoid hits to the head.

## **How Can I Spot a Possible Concussion?**

Children and teens who show or report one or more of the signs and symptoms listed below—or simply say they just “don't feel right” after a bump, blow, or jolt to the head or body—may have a concussion or other serious brain injury.

### **Signs Observed by Parents or Coaches**

- Appears dazed or stunned.
- Forgets an instruction, is confused about an assignment or position, or is unsure of the game, score, or opponent.
- Moves clumsily.
- Answers questions slowly.
- Loses consciousness (even briefly).
- Shows mood, behavior, or personality changes.
- Can't recall events prior to or after a hit or fall.

### **Symptoms Reported by Children and Teens**

- Headache or “pressure” in head.
- Nausea or vomiting.
- Balance problems or dizziness, or double or blurry vision.
- Bothered by light or noise.
- Feeling sluggish, hazy, foggy, or groggy.
- Confusion, concentration, or memory problems.
- Just not “feeling right,” or “feeling down.”

Talk with your children and teens about concussion. Tell them to report their concussion symptoms to you and their coach right away. Some children and teens think concussions aren't serious or worry that if they report a concussion, they will lose their position on the team or look weak. Be sure to remind them that it is better to miss one game than the whole season.

Concussions affect each child and teen differently. While most children and teens with concussions feel better within a couple of weeks, some will have symptoms for months or longer. Talk with your children or teens' health care provider if their concussion symptoms do not go away or if they get worse after they return to their regular activities.

**What Are Some More Serious Danger Signs to Look Out For?**

In rare cases, a dangerous collection of blood (hematoma) may form on the brain after a bump, blow, or jolt to the head or body and can squeeze the brain against the skull. Call 9-1-1 or take your child or teen to the emergency department right away if, after a bump blow, or jolt to the head or body, he or she has one or more of these danger signs:

- One pupil is larger than the other.
- Drowsiness or inability to wake up.
- A headache that gets worse and does not go away.
- Slurred speech, weakness, numbness, or decreased coordination.
- Repeated vomiting or nausea, convulsions, or seizures (shaking or twitching).
- Unusual behavior, increased confusion, restlessness, or agitation.
- Loss of consciousness (passed out/knocked out). Even a brief loss of consciousness should be taken seriously.

Children and teens who continue to play while having concussion symptoms or who return to play too soon—while the brain is still healing— have a greater chance of getting another concussion. A repeat concussion that occurs while the brain is still healing from the first injury can be very serious and can affect a child or teen for a lifetime. It can even be fatal.

**What Should I Do If My Child or Teen Has a Possible Concussion?**

As a parent, if you think your child or teen may have a concussion, you should:

1. Remove your child or teen from play.
2. Keep your child or teen out of play the day of the injury. Your child or teen should be seen by a health care provider and only return to play with permission from a health care provider who is experienced in evaluating for concussion.
3. Ask your child or teen’s health care provider for written instructions on helping your child or teen return to school. You can give the instructions to your child or teen’s school nurse and teacher(s) and return-to-play instructions to the coach and/or athletic trainer.

Do not try to judge the severity of the injury yourself. Only a health care provider should assess a child or teen for a possible concussion. Concussion signs and symptoms often show up soon after the injury. But you may not know how serious the concussion is at first, and some symptoms may not show up for hours or days. The brain needs time to heal after a concussion. A child or teen’s return to school and sports should be a gradual process that is carefully managed and monitored by a health care provider.
